How to Fill

Join top and lower half of ice mold, then fill top hole with water or other liquid. Fill no higher than the H in Happy Roo (or nearly half a cup). Use either faucet on low stream, a funnel device, or a pouring cup with a spout to ensure minimal spillage. If you want berries or mint in your drink, add them in the bottom of the mold before you fill it.



WARNING

Don't leave ice orbs in freezer longer than 2 days or they might crack. Put in plastic bag to keep

How to Chill

Place them in your freezer, or if you're in the arctic tundra, outside.

The time to solidify depends on the temperature of your freezer.

However, you can expect the orbs to take at least a few hours to freeze.

HOW TO POP 'EM

Run frozen Ice orb mold under running water for 5-10 seconds or until opacity changes. Pry halves apart via the seam using fingernails or butter knife. **Check out our how-to videos at happyjoeyroo.com/instructions-and-videos.html**
